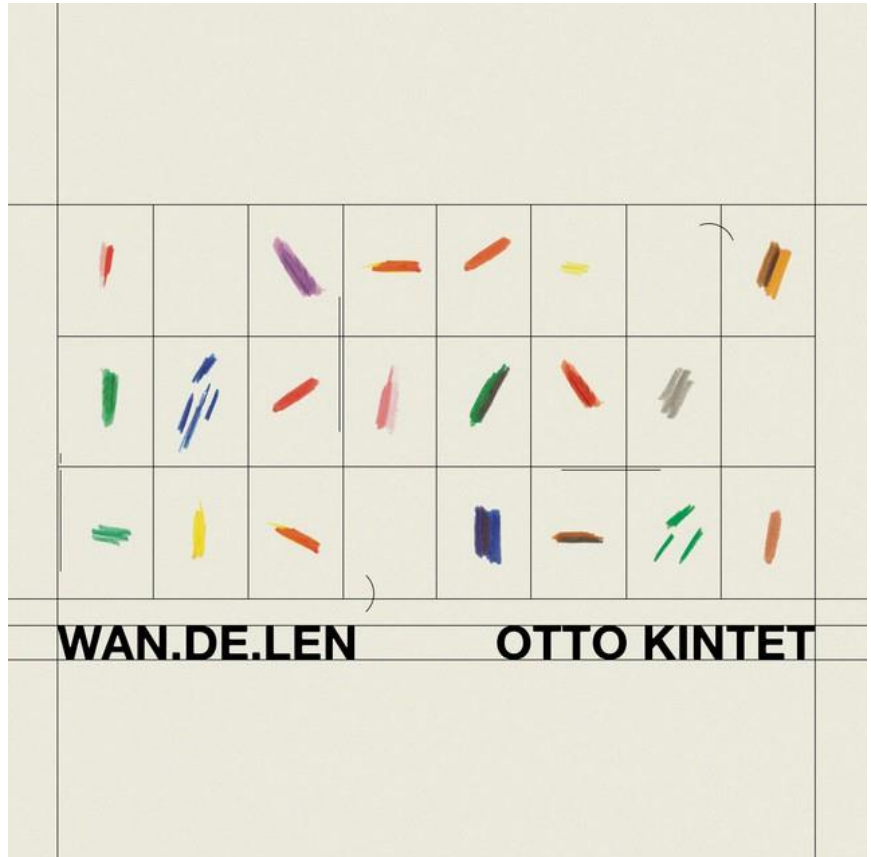


# Otto Kintet - "Wan.de.len": A Journey Through Jazz and Art
