

****JAUNE TOUJOURS - Vertigo****

*** File under: Kick-ass roots / Belgian ska ***

Jaune Toujours is back and better than ever! Since the mid-1990s, this Belgo-Brussels collective has been serving up a blistering mix of **grooves, horns, and accordion**. With the energy of a rock band (without guitars!), the improvisational flair of a jazz combo, the adventurous spirit of musical explorers, and the charisma of street performers, they deliver poetic and poignant reflections on society. Add a touch of typical Brussels self-mockery, and you've got the recipe for a party like no other.

Autumn 2024, **Jaune Toujours** has released their highly anticipated new album ***Vertigo***. The album continues the band's tradition of breaking boundaries - be it linguistic or musical - with lyrics in English, French, and Dutch, catchy songs, a punk attitude, drum & brass, accordion dub, and Belgian ska. On ***Vertigo*** the band pushes even further in their sonic adventure: the accordion is frequently run through effects pedals (ranging from organ sounds to wah-wah and delay), occasionally, a mini-Korg or piano make an appearance, the double bass regularly dives into distortion, occasionally switching to electric bass, while the drums juggle snares and various percussion elements with glee. The horns are richly layered, and the vocals are intricately produced, featuring rich backing vocals and tracks.

The lyrics on ***Vertigo*** provide a snapshot of the world, a world so vast it makes you dizzy (hence: **Vertigo**). Many things are going wrong: climate issues, social inequality, oppression, the dominance of image and discourse, the rise of the far right, wars... But if there is anything that can bring hope, let it be music! The songs on ***Vertigo*** aim to keep spirits up, to persevere, to make the right choices, to turn values into actions, and to make the world a better place. It seems almost impossible, but once we start, there's no stopping us!

Vertigo was recorded at **Choux de Bruxelles** in **Jaune Toujours'** rehearsal space and mixed at **Studio Planet** by **Jules Fradet**, known for his work with Belgian rappers like **Damso, Caballero & Jeanjass, Roméo Elvis, La Smala, and Baloji**. **Choux de Bruxelles** has collaborated with him before on other productions, including **Mec Yek's** album ***SuperDiverCity***. ***Vertigo*** was co-produced by **Jules Fradet** and **Jaune Toujours'** frontman, **Piet Maris**.

Jaune Toujours invites you to join them on a musical journey where borders between genres are crossed, and rules are rewritten. ***Vertigo*** is more than just an album—it's a statement, an invitation to see the world differently, with the same open-mindedness that has defined the band since the 1990s.

Vertigo is available on vinyl, on CD (digi-pack) and digital on all platforms. The CD has 3 extra tracks – with the vinyl comes a downloadcode for all tracks on the CD.

Sustainability The CD is not in a jewelcase but in a cardboard digipack, to avoid as much plastic as possible. For the vinyl, the production opted for the ecological “Rebound Compound”. It consists of 100% post-consumer records from old stocks and thrift shops, which can no longer be sold and risk to end up in the rubbish bin, transformed into new raw material that is indistinguishable from 100% “new” in terms of sight and sound quality. For now, the process only works with black vinyl, hence: no fancy colours for *VERTIGO*, but classy black, with a grammage of 180g for optimal sound quality

Since 2002, Sarah Baur has been designing the covers for Jaune Toujours' albums. For the new album *Vertigo*, the idea was to create something in the style of the fanzines from the 1990s punk rock scene. Combining this with the title *Vertigo* called for a colorful, festive vibe. In line with the fanzine concept and in response to the rise of AI, Sarah decided to work entirely analog. Using paper, scissors, and markers, she created a punky, somewhat anarchistic collage, fitting the band's DIY attitude. She visually translated the Jaune Toujours universe into a galaxy where the colors of reggae and ska take center stage. These colors reflect what the band stands for: community, positivity, and combativeness – all in a danceable way.

Jaune Toujours are overlooking more than 25 years in music as one can find out on 20sth (2017), a collector's album and box-set (limited edition). The box-set contains 8 albums and 9 cd's. BRUSK (2000), CAMPING DEL MUNDO (2002) and the live album CLUB (2006) have been remastered and reprinted for this special occasion. Next to the albums BARRICADE (2004) and KOLEKTIV (2009) you can find the remix album RE:PLUGGED (2010), the album ROUTES (2013) and the collector's album 20sth (2016). In 2018 the sixth full album was added to the discography : EUROPEANA. The album comes as a hardcover photobook + cd 30x30cm, with a with a selection of pictures by drummer-photographer Theophane Raballand, or on vinyl. Autumn 2019, the album has been released on a smaller format (cd - digi-pack). Six years later, Autumn 2024, Jaune Toujours launch *Vertigo*, their seventh (!) studio album on own label Choux de Bruxelles. Kick-ass roots in its most energetic form!
